**CANVASSING BOARD MEETING**

---

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof the Council of Emily, Minnesota held at a Special Council Meeting on Friday November 7, 2008 at 9:03 A.M. for the purpose of canvassing the November 4, 2008 General Election returns. Council members George Pepek, Dan Barrett, Joan Hite, Kent Rees and Gerhart Hanson were present. Also present was City Clerk Patricia Kestner.

The City Clerk presented the election returns as certified by the Election Judges. The returns were reviewed by the Council and found City Election to be as follows:

Total register voters at 7:00 a.m. were 638. Total number registering on Election Day 63, total number voting in person 491 (including new registrations). The number of persons voting by absentee ballot was 71. The number of ballots to be accounted for 562. One person was unable to prove proper proof of residence.
